

Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

Q: If I volunteer what kind of help is needed?

A: There are many types of volunteer assignments. You can be a greeter and welcome the attendees in the lobby. You can sit at the table and ask attendees to sign the Big Books to be presented at the Sunday countdown. You can help at the reservations desk. You can help with putting out cookies at the coffee stations.

Q: Do I have to contact the hotel for room reservations?

A: Yes, and contact the hotel for Confirmation.

Q: Can I register online?

A: Yes, you can for the hotel (see the registration form for instructions). You cannot register online for the meal plans or registration fee.

Q: Can I pay by credit card?

- A: Yes, you can use your credit card for the hotel stay. However, checks and money orders are required for the registration fee and meal plans.
- Q: How do I sign up for the Old-Timers Luncheon?

- A: If you are coming to the old timers' <u>only</u> (you must have 25 or more years), check the "Old Timers' Luncheon" column on the page 3 registration form. If you choose meal package 1, 2, 3, or 4, (see the instructions on page 4), the \$25 fee is already included in the price of the meal package.
- Q: Is the banquet included in the meal plan?
- *A: The banquet is included in the price of Meal Packages 1, 2, or 4.*
- Q: I don't want to attend the Convention, I just want to attend the dances. Can I buy tickets for just the dances?
- *A:* Sorry, the registration fee is inclusive for all events. But your registration fee covers you for Friday and Saturday's dances.
- Q: Can I mail my registration in?
- A: Yes, simply fill out the form on page 3 and mail it in with a check.
- Q: What if I still have questions?
